POOL LOT GETS A GATE

The board recently approved the purchase of a gate to limit access to the recreation area parking lot. The primary reason

for this is to increase security around the pool and for our neighbors who live near the pool. We want to discourage the attractiveness of the privacy of our parking lot for what has become a favorite spot for late night parking. The gate will be unlocked and locked as part of the daily routine of opening and closing the pool during the summer. At other times, you can contact the pool, basketball or tennis committee chairpeople, or a board member if you need to open the lot. The cost of the gate is less than any single instance of recent vandalism.
